

Direct Access Testing

What is Direct Access Testing?

Direct Access Testing allows patients to order their own laboratory tests. It allows individuals who may want to learn more about their health without large out-of-pocket expenses. You are able to request specific laboratory tests without a provider's orders or insurance involvement.

What do you need to know?

- A provider's order is not required.
- No appointment is necessary.
- Anyone under the age of 18 must be accompanied by a parent/guardian.
- **You must pay for the tests in advance by cash, check, or most credit cards; your insurance will not be billed.**
- A picture ID is required at time of service.
- **Results will be sent directly to you.** You are encouraged to share them with your provider/s.
- Direct Access Testing is available Monday through Friday from 8:00AM - 4:00PM at any St. Croix Health clinic. St. Croix Falls clinic also has availability on Saturdays from 8:00AM - 11:30AM. *Please note that laboratory locations are closed from 12:00PM - 1:00PM daily.*
- **You will be responsible for contacting your provider/s regarding any test results. Results will be mailed to you; no results will be posted in your chart and you will not be able to access them via MyChart.**
- When you arrive at the clinic, check in at registration and ask for **Direct Access Testing**.
